Breaking Down the Borders!

For the first time in a long time, our local is aiming for some major ATA recognition in the area of community and public relations! We are attempting to break some records and break down some "borders" within our local communities, and we want to do so with a game or two of BALL!

First border breakdown...

This event will see the staff and their significant others from ECACS take on the staff and significant others from BTPS. There will be games set up in Vermilion as well as Wainwright in order to decrease travel distances. These slow-pitch games will take place on October 15th, 2011. Second border breakdown...

This event will be held in Vermilion in early March when there is still some snow, but not the -50°C weather!
